The confined space standard requires specific practices and procedures that will protect employees from potential hazards of entering confined spaces. Requirements of standards include:

- Identification of confined spaces
- Written program
- Training for individuals who may enter confined spaces
- Permit required confined spaces

Some kind of confined space can be found in over 240,000 workplaces. The work done inside these spaces varies from inspection and testing of equipment to welding, painting, and service/installation equipment.
