

DID YOU KNOW...

CONSTRUCTION YOUTH APPRENTICES CAN RECEIVE CREDIT TOWARDS THEIR REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIP FROM ABC OF WISCONSIN?

Students completing a Youth Apprentices in Architecture and Construction can receive credit towards their Registered Apprenticeship when they go through ABC of Wisconsin.

1-year Youth Apprentice Receives:

- Minimum 250 on the job hours (committee may grant more credit)
- Unpaid Related Instruction Credit for First Aid, CPR, and OSHA* Certification

* OSHA must be 1926 Construction. General Industry OSHA will not qualify for credit.

- Unpaid Related Instruction Credit for completion of their NCCER Core Curriculum Certification.

2-year Youth Apprentice Receives:

- Minimum 450 on the job hours (committee may grant more credit)
- Unpaid Related Instruction Credit for First Aid, CPR, and OSHA* Certification

* OSHA must be 1926 Construction. General Industry OSHA will not qualify for credit.

- Unpaid Related Instruction Credit for completion of their NCCER Core Curriculum Certification.

Applicants must submit a copy of their YA Completion Certificate, work hour verification, copies of their certifications, and complete a credit request form for the ABC Advisory Committee to review.
