## **Unpaid Related Instruction Requirements**

## **Plumbing**

The apprentice must complete satisfactorily <u>260 hours</u> of unpaid school hours, as prescribed by the ABC of WI Apprenticeship Advisory Committee. *The apprentice shall obtain <u>at least 45 hours</u> per year in unpaid related instruction.* 

## Mandatory

## • First Aid/CPR/OSHA

The apprentice shall obtain certification in First Aid and CPR and a minimum of a Construction 10-Hour OSHA Safety course during the first 12 months of the contract. The First Aid and CPR certifications must be kept current.

Please do NOT take online First Aid or CPR courses, as they are not approved by the committee.

Online OSHA courses must be taken through an OSHA-Authorized Online Outreach Training Provider.
