



# Confined Spaces for Construction

At the heart of a successful project is people who have the proper knowledge and skills for all aspects of their job. Confined Spaces require special training and equipment in order to safely complete work. Confined Spaces kill construction workers every month in this country – let's make sure you make it out alive!

**The OSHA regulations involving Confined Spaces affect nearly all contractors.** These new rules will require extensive training on confined space entry which includes many areas on a project site, with attics and crawl spaces being the most common.

## What's Covered:

**This 6-hour interactive course will cover -**

- Identify what types of areas are confined spaces (permit-required confined spaces vs. non-permit spaces)
- Analyze the hazards found in confined spaces
- Assess which confined spaces can be reclassified
- Evaluate various fall hazards
- Understand the operation, use, and limitations of air monitoring equipment
- Identify proper ventilation techniques
- Identify proper non-entry rescue techniques and equipment
- Prepare for both horizontal and vertical entries
- Understand the permitting procedures
- Roles of the permit space entrant(s), attendant, and supervisor
